WOMEN WITH TYPE 2 DIABETES ARE ALMOST TEN TIMES MORE LIKELY TO HAVE HEART DISEASE



WOMEN WITH TYPE 1 DIABETES HAVE AN INCREASED RISK OF MISCARRIAGE OR HAVING A BABY WITH MALFORMATIONS



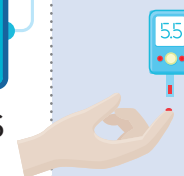
THE CHALLENGE
